Notice of Race

The Organising Authority is the Charteris Bay Yacht Club (CBYC)
395 Marine Drive | PO Box 1, Diamond Harbour 8972

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification and the notation '[NP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means rules that are not grounds for protest by a boat.

1. Rules

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS") and the New Zealand Paper Tiger Class.
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. Appendix T shall apply.

2. Advertising [DP]

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The event is open to all members of the New Zealand Paper Tigers Owners Association (NZPTOA) who are members of a yacht club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand.
- 3.2. Eligible skippers Must enter via [CBYC CLUBHUB](#) by 20 December 2020
- 3.3. Late entries accompanied by the late entry fee may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion until 1700 on 19th January 2021.

4. Fees

- 4.1. The entry fee is \$225.00 (includes Regatta Tee and Prize giving Dinner).
- 4.2. The late fee is an additional \$50 (May not include Tee shirt.)

5.5. Dates of Racing

5.6. Number of Races

- (a) 11 Races are scheduled for the series.
- (b) Up to 4 races may be sailed per day.
- (c) On Friday 22nd January no warning signal will be made after 1500.

6. Measurement

- 6.1. All boats must comply with the rules of the New Zealand Paper Tiger Class.
- 6.2. Boats that were measured and passed at either the 2020 New Zealand Paper Tiger Nationals will not need to be re-measured for the 2021 New Zealand Paper Tiger Nationals with the following provisions:
 - 6.2.1 Skippers shall complete and sign a formal declaration (form to be provided at registration) stating that no changes have been made to their Paper Tiger (including hulls/platform, sail and mast) since its previous measurement in 2020.
 - 6.2.3 That all hull platforms that weighed in at less than 52kg in 2020 must submit their hulls for re-weighing.
- 6.3 All equipment that was not measured and passed at the 2020 Paper Tiger Nationals or prior must be measured for the 2021 Paper Tiger Nationals.
- 6.4 Any equipment previously measured that has been modified must be re-measured.
- 6.5 The class measurer may direct any competing Paper Tiger be measured at any time during the measurement time or during the contest.
- 6.6 All beach trailers/trolleys must have boat names and numbers clearly marked on them.
- 6.7 A safety declaration is to be completed at registration. Note: a safety check may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

7. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will only be available online and a copy posted on the Official Notice Board. The Sailing Instructions may also be posted on the NZPTOA and/or CBYC website prior to registration.

8. Venue

- 8.1. Attachment A shows the location of the event venue.
- 8.2. The Racing area and are the waters known as Te Wharau/Charteris Bay and Lyttelton Harbour.

9. Courses to be Sailed

- 9.1. The courses to be sailed will be triangular courses including windward, reaching, and leeward marks.
- 9.2. The target time for each race will be 40 minutes for the leading boat.

10. Penalty System

Rule 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that the 'Two-Turns' penalty is replaced by the 'One-Turn' Penalty.

11. Scoring

- 11.1. 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2. When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3. When from 6 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4. When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores

12. Support Boats [DP] [NP]

Support boats are permitted but maybe subject to restrictions

13. Launching [DP] [NP]

Unless otherwise directed by the Organizing Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the ramps in front of the CBYC.

14. Radio Communication [DP] [NP]

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15. Prizes

15.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- A Division: 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
- B Division: 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- C Division: 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
- 1st.Female skipper
- 1st place in the following Age groups:
 - Junior
 - Veteran
 - Grand master
 - Great Grand master
 - Legends
- Most improved since previous Nationals sailed

15.2. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the NZPTOA or the Organizing Authority.

16. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in all races entirely at their own risk. Refer to RRS rule 4. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the race.

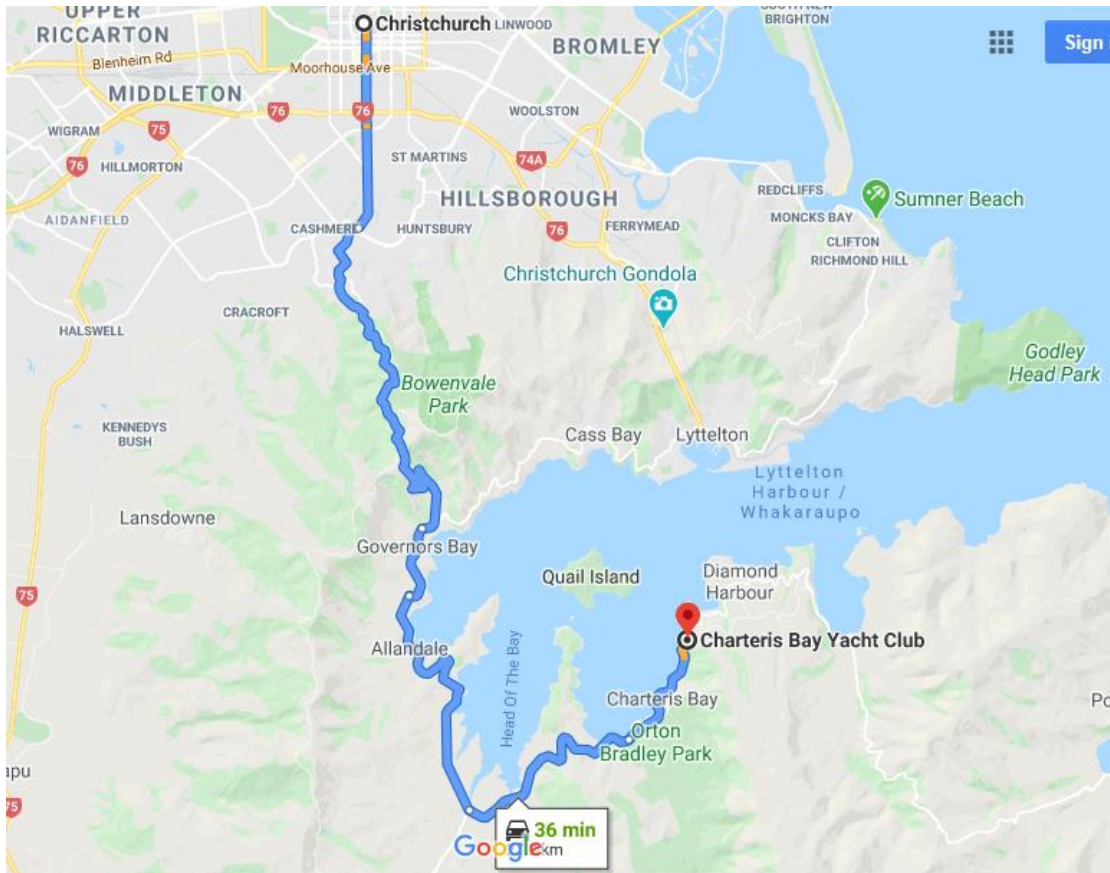
